Background:

The process:

1. Applying for certification:

2. Achieving certification:

An on-site certification audit (at your premises) will be conducted, where we will examine the extent to which you address the program criteria. Areas of concern will be reported. Once we are satisfied there are no outstanding issues that present an unacceptable risk, we can proceed to issue a *Certificate of Confidence*. We will also make a recommendation to CCF to issue their own certificate.

3. Maintaining certification:

Depending on the level of risk, we will conduct annual re-certification audits (and in some cases special and follow-up audits) to examine the extent to which you continue to address the program criteria. Areas of concern will be reported. So long as we continue to be satisfied there are no outstanding issues that present an unacceptable risk, a *Certificate of Confidence* can be re-issued annually. Similarly, we would make a recommendation to CCF to issue their own certificate on an annual basis.
